ME offers private and small group classes year-round, seven days a week. Classes are tailored to each student's schedule, ability, and educational goals. Whether students desire to improve basic skills, prepare for standardized tests, master specialized areas of study, or seek expert help with school applications, our programs enable them to gain the necessary confidence, learning skills, and performance in pursuit of higher academic or professional achievement.

YEAR-ROUND PRIVATE CLASSES

Students may enroll in private classes at any time. Private classes (typically one student, though sometimes two or three friends or siblings together) can be scheduled on a short or long-term basis for the following:

- SAT*, PSAT, ACT, PreACT, AP, IB and SAT Subject Test Prep
- MSP/SBT, SSAT/ISEE, ITBS and COGAT Test Prep
- Full SAT and ACT Practice Tests
- College Counselling and Admissions Prep
- College Application Essay Writing
- College Transfer Assistance
- Language Arts (reading, writing, grammar, vocabulary)
- Math (all levels through calculus and statistics)
- Science (biology, chemistry, physics)
- Home Schooling in English and Math
- ESL (conversation, reading, writing, Compass, TOEFL)
- Homework Help, Editing and Study Skills
- Nursing School Test Prep (TEAS and other tests)
- Special Assignments and Projects

YEAR-ROUND GROUP CLASSES

Students may enroll in group classes at any time. Group classes are limited to 8 students (6 for groups of younger students) and scheduled according to student level for the following:

- SAT Verbal Preparation (grades 9-12)
- SAT Math Preparation (grades 9-12)
- ACT Verbal Preparation (grades 9-12)
- ACT Math/Science Preparation (grades 9-12)
- Calculus Fundamentals & Beyond (see course description)
- Language Arts & Test Prep (grades 3 and higher)
- College Application Essay Writing (seniors)

SUMMER CAMPS

ME has gained recognition for its exceptional summer programs in language arts, mathematics, test preparation, and college admissions. Students are carefully assessed and attend small group courses (up to 6 students Learning Camp, 8 students other camps) customized to meet their academic needs and to prepare them for the challenges of the coming year.

SAT/COLLEGE PREP CAMP (entering grades 9-12)

Students receive approximately 100 hours of instruction (5 hrs a day, M-F, 9:30am-3pm) over four weeks. Classes cover SAT writing & language, reading, and math. Students further develop their writing skills as they create resumes and college application essays. Our integrative curriculum surpasses standard test prep programs and prepares students for academic success in high school as well as college.

ACT/COLLEGE PREP CAMP

(entering grades 9-12)

Students receive approximately 100 hours of instruction (5 hours a day, M-F, 9:30am-3pm) over four weeks. Classes cover ACT writing, English, reading, math, and science. Students further develop their writing skills as they create resumes and college application essays. Our integrative curriculum surpasses standard test prep programs and prepares students for academic success in high school as well as college.

LEARNING CAMP (entering grades 3-8)

This innovative program provides approximately 100 hours of instruction (5 hrs a day, M-F, 9am-2:30pm) over four weeks in language arts, math, standardized test-taking strategies, and LEGO Mindstorms (a course in robotics developed by MIT). Students (not exceeding 6 per class) gain a lasting learning experience in which they develop language, math, problem-solving, computer, and collaborative skills.

ADVANCED SAT VERBAL CAMP

(entering grades 11-12)

This program is designed for students who have scored at least 640 on the reading/writing & language section and 4/4/4 or higher on the essay section of one of ME's Practice SAT tests (or other recent SAT test). This class follows a fast-paced, intensive curriculum designed to fine-tune students' performance on the SAT. Group meets approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Mon/Thurs or Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm.

ADVANCED SAT MATH CAMP

(entering grades 11-12)

This program is for students who have scored at least 640 on the math portion on one of ME's Practice SAT tests (or other recent SAT test) and have previously studied an Algebra II course. Students will follow a fast-paced, intensive, academically challenging curriculum designed to improve students' performance in SAT math. Group meets for approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Mon/Thurs or Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS PREP CAMP

(Session II only, limited to 6 seniors)

This course is for students who wish to take charge of the college admissions process to maximize their chances of gaining access to the college(s) of their choice. Course work focuses on application essays, academic profile and resume development, college selection, strategic application planning, and interview practice. Group meets approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm. (Additional Wed/Sat group, 3:30pm/9:30am, may be added.)

FEE SCHEDULE

Students can enroll at any time and start classes on a "first come-first serve" basis throughout the year. A \$40 registration fee and refundable \$200 deposit are required. Tuition is based on 2-month blocks of pre-scheduled classes. Books and materials are not included in tuition.

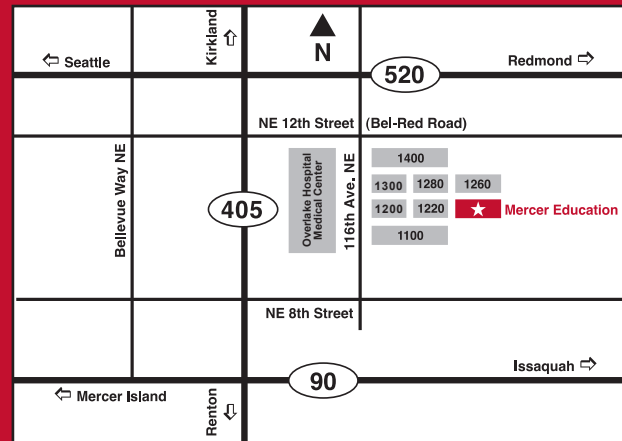
