PRIVATE CLASSES

Students may enroll in private classes at any time of the year. Private classes can be scheduled on a short- or long-term basis for the following:

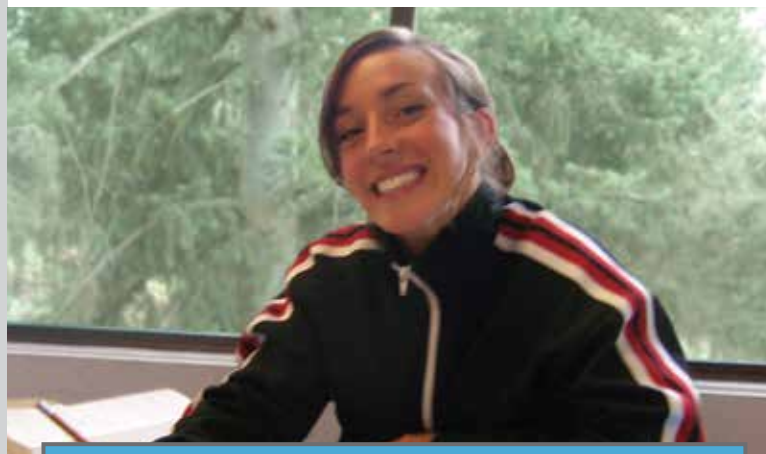
- College and Admissions Counseling (at all school levels)

GROUP CLASSES

Students may enroll in group classes at any time of the year. Group classes are kept very small – 8 students for SAT and ACT prep, 6 for Language Arts and 6 for College Application Essay Writing (and slightly larger for online classes) – and scheduled according to student level for the following:

- SAT Verbal Prep
- SAT Math Prep
- ACT Verbal Prep
- ACT Math/Science Prep
- Writing Fundamentals
- Language Arts

SUMMER CAMPS

ME has gained recognition for its exceptional summer programs in language arts, mathematics, test preparation, and college admissions. Students are carefully assessed and attend small group courses - 8 students for SAT and ACT prep, 6 for Language Arts and 6 for College Application Essay Writing (and slightly larger for online classes) - customized to meet their academic needs and to prepare them for the challenges of the coming year.

SAT/COLLEGE PREP CAMP (entering grades 9 -12)

Students receive approximately 100 hours of instruction (5 hrs a day, M-F, 9:30am-3pm) over four weeks. Classes cover SAT writing & language, reading, and math. Students further develop their writing skills as they create resumes and college application essays. Our integrative curriculum surpasses standard test prep programs and prepares students for academic success in high school as well as college.

ACT/COLLEGE PREP CAMP

(entering grades 9-12)

Students receive approximately 100 hours of instruction (5 hours a day, M-F, 9:30am-3pm) over four weeks. Classes cover ACT writing, English, reading, math, and science. Students further develop their writing skills as they create resumes and college application essays. Our integrative curriculum surpasses standard test prep programs and prepares students for academic success in high school as well as college.

LEARNING CAMP (entering grades 3 - 9)

This popular, established program provides approximately 50 hours of instruction over four weeks. Students (not exceeding 8 per class) gain a lasting learning experience in which they develop language skills – reading, writing, grammar, vocabulary, and critical thinking – with experienced instructors and a manageable amount of screen time. (2.5 hours a day, M-F, 9:30am - noon or 12:30pm - 3:00pm). Curriculum different each session and year. Apply early – spaces fill up fast!

ADVANCED SAT VERBAL CAMP

(entering grades 11-12)

This program is designed for students who have scored at least 640 on the reading/writing & language section of one of ME’s Practice SAT tests (or other recent SAT test). This class follows a fast-paced, intensive curriculum designed to fine-tune students’ performance on the SAT. Group meets approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Mon/Thurs or Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm.

ADVANCED SAT MATH CAMP

(entering grades 11-12)

This program is for students who have scored at least 640 on the math portion on one of ME’s Practice SAT tests (or other recent SAT test) and have previously studied an Algebra II course. Students will follow a fast-paced, intensive, academically challenging curriculum designed to improve students’ performance in SAT math. Group meets for approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Mon/Thurs or Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS PREP CAMP

(Session II only, limited to 6 seniors)

This course is for students who wish to take charge of the college admissions process to maximize their chances of gaining access to the college(s) of their choice. Course work focuses on application essays, academic profile and resume development, college selection, strategic application planning, and interview practice. Group meets approximately 20 hours (2.5 hours twice a week, Tues/Fri) over four weeks. Classes 3:30-6:00pm.

FEE SCHEDULE

Students can enroll at any time and start classes on a "first come-first serve" basis throughout the year. There is a one-time \$40 registration fee per family. Tuition is based on 2-month blocks of pre-scheduled classes. Books and materials are not included in tuition.
